



Blue Membership Ticket Promotion (the “Promotion”)

Terms and Conditions of the Promotion (the "T&Cs")

Promoters

1. This Promotion is organised and promoted by Manchester City Football Club Limited (company number 00040946) whose registered office is at Etihad Stadium, Etihad Campus, Manchester, M11 3FF (the “**Promoter**”).

The Competition

2. The Promotion shall start at 09.00 (GMT) on Thursday 30 August 2012 (“**Promotion Opening**”). The Promotion will close at 23:59 (GMT) on Sunday 30 September 2012 (“**Promotion Closing**”).

3. Every person who has purchased one of the Promoter’s standard Blue Memberships for the 2012/13 UK football season (for the avoidance of doubt, Blue City Kicks members are not eligible for the Promotion) before the Promotion Closing (an “**Entrant**”) shall be automatically entered into a prize draw (the “**Draw**”) to win one of 20 pairs of football tickets to watch the Promoter’s men’s first team in a home group stage UEFA Champions League match in the 2012/13 football season (the “**Tickets**”).

4. Blue Membership may be purchased online at www.mcfc.co.uk/blue, by calling 0161 444 1894 (24-hour) (please note a £2.50 booking fee per membership applies) or in person at the Promoter's Ticket Office located at the Etihad Stadium and are subject to the Promoter's Membership terms and conditions of purchase available at www.mcfc.co.uk/Tickets-and-Membership/Terms-and-Conditions. There is a limit of one entry for each Blue Membership purchased.

5. Entrants must be aged 16 or over at the date on which their Blue Membership is purchased to qualify for entry to the Draw.

6. The Promoter shall be entitled at any time throughout the Competition to request supporting documentation from Entrants in order to obtain proof that the above conditions have been satisfied and that the Entrant in question is therefore eligible to enter the Draw.

7. The Promoter reserves the right to disregard from the Draw any person who is not eligible to enter or has otherwise not complied with these T&Cs.

8. The Promoter will, during the period commencing on the Promotion Opening and ending on a date after the Promotion Closing when all Tickets have been won, select 20 Entrants at random, each of whom will receive one pair of Tickets (the “**Winners**”). The Promoter’s decision shall be final in this respect and as regards the applicable to each pair of Tickets.

9. The names and / or images of the Winners may be made available for viewing by the public on the Promoter’s website once they have been selected and at any other location and/or in any other media at the Promoter’s choice.



10. The Promoter shall notify the Winners that they have won the Promotion as soon as possible before the date of the match to which their Tickets relate and shall provide instructions for claiming their Tickets using the contact details provided by the Entrant when purchasing their Blue Membership.

11. Tickets shall be provided to Winners subject to the Promoter's Home Ticket terms and conditions of sale available at www.mcfc.co.uk/Tickets-and-Membership/Terms-and-Conditions. By accepting Tickets, Winners agree to adhere to these Home Ticket terms and conditions and shall ensure the same is communicated to the user of their additional Ticket.

12. In respect of each pair of Tickets, one Ticket must be used by the Winner. If any Winner is unable to attend the game chosen by the Promoter, the Promoter shall aim to provide Tickets to an alternative qualifying game but shall be under no obligation to do so. If it is not possible to find suitable alternative Tickets and the Winner remains unable to attend the relevant match, the Winner shall forfeit the Tickets and the Promoter shall select a new Winner.

13. Each Winner (and their guest if they are in possession of the same) shall have their membership card activated for the relevant match and shall receive e-mail confirmation of activation. A paper Ticket will be sent by post before the relevant match (or will be left for collection at the Etihad Stadium where this is not possible) if any guest of a Winner is not in possession of a valid membership card.

14. Tickets are for the personal use of the Winners only and may not be used for any commercial or promotional purpose. The Tickets shall be non-refundable, for money or at all. There will be no cash or other alternative for the Tickets.

15. The Promoter reserves the right to amend any dates and times set out in these T&Cs (including the dates and times of the relevant match) or otherwise (including, without limitation, verbally) and to terminate the Promotion, at any time without liability to any entrant or potential entrant. The Promoter's decision in this respect shall be final.

16. A copy of these T&Cs will be available during all stages of the Promotion on the Promoter's website or on written request to the Promoter at Supporter Services, Manchester City Football Club, Etihad Stadium, Etihad Campus, Manchester, M11 3FF.

17. By using the Tickets, all Winners acknowledge and agree that photographic images and / or video recordings (and / or stills taken from video recordings) may be taken of them and may also be used in live television coverage of the relevant match and / or for promotional or marketing purposes by the Promoter and / or on the Promoter's website.

Entrant's Warranties

18. By accepting Tickets, each Entrant warrants that he/she:

- a. has read, understood and agrees to adhere to these T&Cs and the Home Ticket Terms and Conditions;
- b. is eligible to enter the Promotion;



- c. has not and shall not enter into any agreement or arrangement with any person in respect of his/her Entry into the Promotion or the Tickets;
- d. shall observe and adhere to all rules and instructions (including fire safety and security arrangements) in force or given by the Promoter in relation to any location attended by the entrant in connection with the Promotion; and
- e. has submitted to the Promoter personal details and/or any other information which is truthful, accurate and in no way misleading and shall inform the Promoter immediately if this information becomes inaccurate.

Disqualification from the Competition

19. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify, at its sole discretion, any Entrant who:

- a. provides untruthful, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information;
- b. fails to abide by these T&Cs; or
- c. is deemed in the Promoter's opinion to be acting or to have acted outside the spirit of the Promotion.

20. The Promoter's decision to disqualify any Entrant in accordance with condition 19 above shall be final.

21. The Promoter will endeavour to operate the Promotion and apply the T&Cs and any additional rules fairly and consistently.

Data Protection

22. All Personal Data held by the Promoter will be held and used in accordance with the Promoter's privacy policy (which can be found at www.mcfc.co.uk/common/privacy) and the Data Protection Act 1998.

Force Majeure

23. The Promoter shall not be liable for any failure to comply with its obligations in relation to the Promotion where the failure is caused by something outside their reasonable control. Such circumstances shall include, but not be limited to, weather conditions, fire, flood, hurricane, strike, industrial dispute, war, hostilities, political unrest, riots, civil commotion, inevitable accidents, supervening legislation or any other circumstances amounting to a force majeure event.

Limited Liability

24. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment (direct or indirect) incurred or suffered by any entrant as a result of entering the Promotion, accepting the Tickets or any change to the date or time of the match to which any Tickets relates. Nothing in these T&Cs shall exclude the liability of the Promoter



for death or personal injury occurring as a result of its negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation.

Severability

25. If any provision, or any part of a provision, of these T&Cs or any other rules or guidance relating to the Promotion (the “**Rules**”) is adjudged by a court to be void or unenforceable, then such provision or the part in question shall in no way affect any other provision of the Rules which shall be construed only to the extent necessary to bring it within legal requirement as if such invalid or unenforceable part did not exist.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction

26. These T&Cs and the Rules shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law and the English courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
